



# Miscellaneous Financial Provisions Act 1955

1955 CHAPTER 64 and 5 Eliz 2

## 4 Winding up of Road Fund.

<sup>F1</sup>(1) .....

(2) After the winding up of the Road Fund any expenditure incurred by [<sup>F2</sup>the Secretary of State] which would otherwise have been defrayed out of the Road Fund shall be defrayed out of moneys provided by Parliament and—

- (a) any reference in any enactment to the making of payments out of the Road Fund shall be taken as a reference to the making of payments out of moneys provided by Parliament;
- (b) any reference in any enactment to the making of payments into the Road Fund shall be taken as a reference to the making of payments into the Exchequer.

<sup>F3</sup>(3) .....

(4) On the winding up of the Road Fund the consequential amendments specified in the First Schedule to this Act shall take effect, . . . <sup>F4</sup>
