GUARANTEED PRICES AND ASSURED MARKETS

8 Provision for application to additional produce and variation of minimum percentages.

[^{F2}(2) The Ministers may,^{F3} from time to time^{F4}, take into consideration in consultation with producers the percentages specified in subsection (1) and subsection (2) of section two^{F5} of this Act, and may by order substitute for any of those percentages such other percentage as they consider appropriate:
Provided that an order under this subsection shall not apply in relation to any determination made within twelve months after the date on which the order is made.]
