## FOURTH SCHEDULE

#### SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS AS TO EXERCISE OF CERTAIN POWERS

Any person who, in consequence of the exercise of any power in relation to which this paragraph applies, suffers loss by reason of damage to, or is disturbed in the enjoyment of, any land or chattels shall be entitled to compensation in respect of that damage or disturbance from the Minister or local authority on whose behalf the power is exercised: and any dispute as to a right to compensation under this paragraph, or as to the amount of any such compensation, shall be determined by the [<sup>F1</sup>appropriate tribunal].
