



# Home Safety Act 1961

1961 CHAPTER 20 9 and 10 Eliz 2

## 1 Promotion of safety in the home.

- (1) A local authority may promote safety in the home by publishing or making arrangements for otherwise giving information or advice relating to the prevention of accidents in the home.
- (2) A local authority may make contributions to any organisation whose activities are carried on otherwise than for profit and consist of or include the promotion of safety in the home.

- (4) In this Act “local authority” means the council of a county district . . . <sup>F2</sup>
