- ^{F1}(1) It is hereby declared that for the purposes of [^{F2}the provisions mentioned in subsection (2)] the ^{M1}Law Reform (Contributory Negligence) Act 1945 (including that Act as applied to Scotland), and section two of the ^{M2}Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland) 1948, are provisions of the law of the United Kingdom under which a court may exonerate the carrier wholly or partly from his liability.
- [^{F3}(2) The provisions are—
 - (a) Article 21 of the Convention;
 - (b) Article 21 of the Convention as amended; and
 - (c) Article 20 of the Montreal Convention.]
