### Prohibition of employment of women after childbirth.

61 If the occupier of a factory knowingly allows a woman or girl to be employed therein within four weeks after she has given birth to a child he shall be liable to a fine not exceeding [<sup>F1</sup>level 1 on the standard scale], or if the offence was committed during the night [<sup>F1</sup>level 1 on the standard scale], pounds for each person so employed, and in the case of a second or subsequent conviction within two years after the last conviction for the like offence not less than [<sup>F1</sup>level 1 on the standard scale] for each offence.
