



Duchy Of Lancaster Act 1808

1808 CHAPTER 73 48 Geo 3

An Act to improve the Land Revenue of the Crown in *England*, and also of His Majesty's Duchy of *Lancaster*. [18th June 1808]

Whereas an Act passed in the Thirty-fourth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, An Act for the better Management of the Land Revenue of the Crown, and for the Sale of Fee Farm and other unimproveable Rents; and it is expedient, that further Provisions should be made for the better Management of the Land Revenues of the Crown within the ordering and Survey of the Exchequer, and of the Duchy of *Lancaster*;
