1808 CHAPTER 73

III No Lease for Lives of Crown Lands to be granted in future.

And be it further enacted, That from and after the passing of this Act no Lease of any Land or Ground belonging or hereafter to belong to His Majesty, His Heirs or Successors, within the ordering and Survey of the Exchequer in *England*, shall in future be granted for any Life or Lives; any Thing in any former Act of Parliament to the contrary notwithstanding excepting only such Lease or Leases for Lives, as in and by a certain Act passed in the Forty-fourth Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, *An Act for inclosing Lands in the Parish of* Great Staughton *in the County of* Huntingdon, is and are authorized to be granted.
