SALE OF OFFICES ACT 1809 (REPEALED)

Provisions of 5 & 6 Ed. 6. c. 16 extended to other offices. When right of appointment forfeited, to go to his Majesty. Persons buying or selling offices, or receiving or paying money or rewards for offices, guilty of a misdemeanor. Persons receiving or paying money for soliciting offices, and any negociations and pretended negociations relating thereto, guilty of a misdemeanor. Persons opening or advertising houses for transacting business relating to the sale of offices, guilty of a misdemeanor. Inflicting a penalty on persons advertising or publishing the names of brokers or agents. 7, 8 Act not to extend to offices excepted in former Act, nor to securities or transactions under legal securities. 10 Act not to extend to lawful deputations where payment of principal or deputy is out of the fees. 11 Act not to extend to annual payments out of the fees of any office, to any person formerly holding such office. 13 Manner of punishing offenders in Scotland.

Offences committed abroad shall be tried in King's Bench.
