1921 CHAPTER 49 11 and 12 Geo 5

9 Regulations to be laid before Parliament.

Every order and every regulation made under this Act shall be laid before each House of Parliament forthwith, and, unless and until an address is presented to His Majesty by either House of Parliament within the next subsequent twenty-one days on which that House has sat next after any such order or regulation is laid before it, praying that the order or regulation may be annulled, the order or regulation shall have effect . . . ^{F1}.
