



Universities (Scotland) Act 1922

1922 CHAPTER 31 12 and 13 Geo 5

2 Lecturers and readers to be members of general councils.

A lecturer or reader appointed by the university court of a Scottish university who has held the office of lecturer or reader therein for one year shall thenceforward, during his tenure of that office, be a member of the general council of that university and entitled to all the rights and privileges of a member of council although his name is not entered in the register of the council: . . . ^{F1}
