AUTOMATIC SALE OF TENANTED LAND

20 Definition of tenanted land

For the purposes of this Part of this Act the expression "tenanted land" means land held for a statutory term or under any contract of tenancy other than a fee farm grant, or lease for lives or years renewable for ever or lease for a term of years of which sixty or more are unexpired:

Provided that land which has become tenanted land as above denned by reason of a contract of tenancy entered into on or after the sixteenth day of December, nineteen hundred and twenty-four, shall be deemed not to be tenanted land for the purposes of this Part of this Act.
