### 2 Appointment of sheriff clerk and procurator fiscal deputes.

In each [<sup>F1</sup>sheriffdom] or district the [<sup>F2</sup>Scottish Court Service]<sup>F2</sup> and the Lord Advocate may respectively, <sup>F3</sup> . . . , appoint such sheriff clerk deputes or procurator fiscal deputes as may be necessary.
