## 2 Alteration of the style of Parliament.

- (1) Parliament shall hereafter be known as and styled the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland; . . .<sup>F2</sup>
- (2) In every . . .<sup>F3</sup> public document issued after the passing of this Act the expression “United Kingdom” shall, unless the context otherwise requires, mean Great Britain and Northern Ireland.
