2 Alteration of the style of Parliament. **U.K.**

- (1) Parliament shall hereafter be known as and styled the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland; . . . ^{F1}
- (2) In every . . . ^{F2} public document issued after the passing of this Act the expression “United Kingdom” shall, unless the context otherwise requires, mean Great Britain and Northern Ireland.
