- (a) In construing, for the purposes of this schedule, or any Order made thereunder, any enactment incorporated with the Order, this Act together with the Order shall be deemed to be the Special Act, and the Board or the local authority, as the case may be, shall be deemed to be the promoters of the undertaking.
 - (b) In this schedule, the expression “land” includes water and any right or servitude to or over land or water, and “prescribed” means prescribed by the Secretary for Scotland.
