If the occupier of a factory<sup>F4</sup> . . . knowingly allows a woman to be employed therein within four weeks after she has given birth to a child, he shall be liable to a fine not exceeding [<sup>F5</sup>level 1 on the standard scale].<sup>F6</sup>...
