6 Application to Scotland.

In the application of this Act to Scotland—

- [^{F1}(a) references to [^{F2}the Secretary of State] shall be construed as references to the Secretary of State;.]
- (b) the expression “Registration Acts” means [^{F3}the ^{M1}Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages (Scotland) Act 1965], and the expression “Registrar-General” means the Registrar-General of Births, Deaths and Marriages in Scotland;
- (c) for any reference to a registration officer there shall be substituted a reference to a registrar as defined in the ^{M2}Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages (Scotland) Act, 1854;
