MARRIAGE UNDER [^{F1}MARRIAGE SCHEDULE]

Issue of [^{F1}a marriage schedule]

[^{F1}28B Provision of evidence

- (1) A notice of marriage under section 27 must, in relation to each of the parties to the marriage, be accompanied by specified evidence of the following matters—
- the person's name and surname;
 - the person's date of birth;
 - the person's place of residence;
 - the person's nationality.

[If a party to the marriage is a relevant national within the meaning of paragraph (ab)^{F2}(1A) of the definition of “relevant national” in section 78(1), the notice of marriage under section 27 must also be accompanied—

- where the party falls within paragraph (ab)(i) of that definition, by an electronic certificate which confirms that the leave referred to in that provision has been granted; or
 - where the party falls within paragraph (ab)(ii) of that definition—
 - by a certificate of application which confirms that the application referred to in regulation 4 of the Citizens’ Rights (Application Deadline and Temporary Protection) (EU Exit) Regulations 2020 has been made; and
 - by evidence that the relevant period referred to in regulation 4 of those Regulations has not expired.]
- (2) A person giving a notice of marriage under section 27 must provide the superintendent registrar to whom the notice is given with specified evidence—

 - (b) if so, as to the ending of the marriage or civil partnership.
- (3) In this section “specified evidence” means evidence that is in accordance with regulations made under section 28G.]
