Grant, effect and term of patent

22 Date and term of patent.

- (1) Every patent shall be dated with the date of filing of the complete specification: Provided that no proceeding shall be taken in respect of an infringement committed before the date of the publication of the complete specification.
- (2) The date of every patent shall be entered in the register of patents.
- (3) Except as otherwise expressly provided by this Act, the term of every patent shall be sixteen years from the date of the patent.
