In deciding any [^{F2}appeal under any provision of this Act, the appropriate tribunal]—

- (a) need not consider any issue that is not raised by the appellant or the Minister in relation to the appeal; and
- (b) shall not take into account any circumstances not obtaining at the time when the decision appealed against was made.]
