

Pensions Appeal Tribunals Act 1943

1943 CHAPTER 39 6 and 7 Geo 6

9 Notices.

Any notice given by the Minister under this Act shall be in writing and may be sent by post to the last known or usual place of abode of the claimant or any person authorised to act on his behalf in relation to the claim and, in the case of a notice of a decision from which an appeal lies to the [FI appropriate tribunal], shall specify that fact and the time within which and the manner in which notice of such an appeal must be given.
