

Commissioners Clauses Act 1847

1847 CHAPTER 16 10 and 11 Vict

Commissioners

16 Commissioners neglecting to act to cease to be one.

Every commissioner who for the space of six months after his appointment neglects to make and subscribe the declaration hereinbefore required, or who for six months in succession is absent from all meetings of the commissioners, and to act in the execution of this and the special Act, shall be deemed to have refused to act, and shall cease to be a commissioner.
