

Commissioners Clauses Act 1847

1847 CHAPTER 16 10 and 11 Vict

Mortgages

Register of mortgages to be kept and to be open to inspection.

A register of mortgages or assignations in security shall be kept by the clerk to the commissioners, and where by the special Act the commissioners are authorized or required to raise separate sums on separate rates or other property a separate register shall be kept for each class of mortgages or assignations in security; and within fourteen days after the date of any mortgage or assignation in security an entry or memorial of the number and date thereof, and of the names of the parties thereto, with their proper additions, shall be made in the proper register, and every such register may be perused at all reasonable times by any person interested in any such mortgage or assignation in security, without fee or reward.
