



# Treason Felony Act 1848

1848 CHAPTER 12 11 and 12 Vict

## 8 As to the punishment of accessories before and after the fact.

In the case of every felony punishable under this Act, every principal in the second degree and every accessory before the fact shall be punishable in the same manner as the principal in the first degree is by this Act punishable; and every accessory after the fact to any such felony shall on conviction be liable to be imprisoned, . . . . .<sup>F1</sup> for any term not exceeding two years.
