Error

CLXVIProceedings upon Death or sole Defendant or of all the Defendants in Error.

In case of the Death of a sole Defendant or of all the Defendants in Error, the Plaintiff in Error may proceed upon giving Ten Days Notice of the Proceedings in Error, and of his Intention to continue the same, to the Representatives of the deceased Defendants, or if no such Notice can be given, then, by Leave of the Court or a Judge, upon giving such Notice to the Parties interested as he or they may direct.
