CHAPTER 134

BURIAL ACT 1853

- 1 On representation of Secretary of State, Her Majesty in Council may restrain the opening of new burial grounds, and order discontinuance of burials in specified places.
- 2 Order not to extend to burial grounds of Quakers or Jews, unless expressly included.
- 3 Burial not to take place after Order in Council for discontinuance.
- 4 Saving of certain rights to bury in vaults, &c.
- Not to extend to cemeteries established by Act of Parliament, or new burial grounds, &c.
