1853 CHAPTER 33 16 and 17 Vict

19 Penalty for offences against this Act for which no penalty is appointed.

For every offence against the provisions of this Act, for which no special penalty is herein-before appointed, the offender shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding [^{F1}level 1 on the standard scale], . . . ^{F2}
