1853 CHAPTER 83 16 and 17 Vict

2 except in criminal cases and in cases of adultery.

Nothing herein shall render any husband competent or compellable to give evidence for or against his wife, or any wife competent or compellable to give evidence for or against her husband, in any criminal proceeding,^{F1}
