



Privy Council Registrar Act 1853

1853 CHAPTER 85 16 and 17 Vict

2 President of the Council may appoint a person to act for registrar in his absence.

In case of the absence of the said registrar it shall be lawful for the President of Her Majesty's Privy Council [^{F1}, after consulting the President of the Supreme Court of the United Kingdom,]^{F1} to appoint a person to act for the said registrar during such absence; and such person while so acting shall have the same powers in all respects as are vested in the said registrar.
