

# Universities (Scotland) Act 1858

### 1858 CHAPTER 83 21 and 22 Vict

### 4 University courts to be constituted.

There shall be constituted in each of the said Universities a University court, which shall<sup>F1</sup>... possess and exercise the powers herein-after enacted, and of which the rector shall be the ordinary president, with a deliberative and a casting vote.
