1860 CHAPTER 124 23 and 24 Vict

14 Preference may be given to places where contribution is made in aid of grant.

In making additional provision for the cure of souls under section sixty-seven of the ^{M1}Ecclesiastical Commissioners Act 1840, preference may be given, if the said Commissioners see fit, to those places in respect of which contributions from other sources are made in aid of grants out of the common fund^{F1}...
