METROPOLITAN POLICE (RECEIVER) ACT 1861

- 1 Receiver constituted a Corporation Sole.
- 2 Transfer of Property vested in previous Receivers.
- 3 Exoneration of Receiver of Metropolitan Police District.
- 4 Alteration of Name of Account at Bank of England.
- 5 Power of Receiver to purchase, &c.
- 6 Power to grant Pensions and compassionate Allowances to Widows and Children of Constables killed in the Execution of their Duty.
- 7 Repeal of Part of Sect. 25 of 10G.4. c.44. and enactment of new Provisions in lieu thereof.
- 8 Payment of Monies into the Bank.
- 9 This and previous Acts to be construed as One.
- 10 Short Title.
