

# Harbours and Passing Tolls, &c. Act 1861

## 1861 CHAPTER 47 24 and 25 Vict

### U.K.

An Act to facilitate the Construction and Improvement of Harbours by authorizing Loans to Harbour Authorities; to abolish Passing Tolls; and for other Purposes. [1st August 1861]
