1862 CHAPTER 37 25 and 26 Vict

7 As to descent of the private estates of the Sovereign.

On the demise of Her Majesty, her heirs or successors, the private estates of Her Majesty, her heirs or successors, shall, subject and without prejudice to any disposition which shall have been made thereof under the authority of the ^{M1}Crown Private Estate Act 1800, or of this Act, descend or go in manner prescribed by, and (according to the nature thereof) be subject to, the provisions and restrictions respectively referred to in the fifth section of the ^{M2}Crown Private Estate Act 1800.
