CHAPTER 18

CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ACT 1865

- 1 Provisions of sect. 2. of this Act to apply to trials commenced on or after July 1, 1865.
- 2 Summing up of evidence in cases of felony and misdemeanor.
- 3 How far witness may be discredited by the party producing.
- 4 As to proof of contradictory statements of adverse witness.
- 5 Cross-examinations as to previous statements in writing.
- 6 Proof of previous conviction of witness may be given.
- 7 As to proof by attesting witnesses.
- 8 As to comparison of disputed writing.
- 9 "Counsel."
- 10 Not to apply to Scotland.
