LXXIIIProvisions for securing the better Performance of Spiritual Duties in ill-endowed Parishes.

And be it enacted, with an especial View to the better Care of populous Parishes, That Arrangements may from Time to Time be made by the like Authority, for improving the; Value or making a better Pro vision for the Spiritual Duties of ill-endowed Parishes or Districts, by means of such Exchange of Advowsons, or of such other Alterations in the Exercise of Patronage, as may be agreed upon by Patrons, with the Consent of the Bishop in every such Case, or in the Case of Benefices lying in more than one Diocese, then with the Consent of the Bishop of each Diocese, and, where a Bishop is himself one of the Patrons, with the Consent of the Archbishop.
