

Metropolitan Streets Act Amendment Act 1867

1867 CHAPTER 5 31 and 32 Vict

1 Amendment of section 6 of 30 & 31 Vict. c. 134.

The sixth section of the Metropolitan Streets Act, 1867, prohibiting the deposit of goods in the streets, shall not apply to costermongers, street hawkers, or itinerant traders, so long as they carry on their business in accordance with the regulations from time to time made by the Commissioner of Police, with the approval of the Secretary of State; . . . ^{F1}
