Oath of Allegiance. Official and Judicial Oaths

2 Form of oath of allegiance.

The oath in this Act referred to as the oath of allegiance shall be in the form following; that is to say,

"I, , do swear that I will be faithful and bear true allegiance to Her Majesty Queen Victoria, her heirs and successors, according to law. So help me God."
