

Metropolitan Public Carriage Act 1869

1869 CHAPTER 115 32 and 33 Vict

Regulations relating to Hackney and Stage Carriages

12 Powers to carry Act into execution.

The said Secretary of State may appoint such officers and constables of the metropolitan police force, and for the city of London of the city police, as he thinks fit to perform any duties required to be performed for the purposes of carrying this Act into execution, and may award such sums by way of compensation for their services out of the monies raised under this Act as he may think just.
