



Burgh Customs (Scotland) Act 1870

1870 CHAPTER 42 33 and 34 Vict

1 Interpretation of terms.

The word “burgh” shall mean any royal, parliamentary, or other burgh, as defined by the word “burgh” in the ^{M1}General Police and Improvement Act (Scotland), 1862, and in which heretofore petty customs have been levied or leviabie.
