GENERAL PROVISIONS

Byelaws

[^{F1}47 Penalties may be imposed in byelaws. **E+W+S**

Any such byelaw may impose reasonable penalties for offences against the same, not exceeding [^{F2}level 1 on the standard scale]] for each offence, with or without further penalties for continuing offences, not exceeding for any continuing offence [^{F3}50p] for every day during which the offence continues; but all byelaws shall be so framed as to allow in every case part only of the maximum penalty being ordered to be paid.
