Legal Procedure

29 Indemnity to Secretary of State or chief executive authority.

The Secretary of State shall not, [^{F1}nor shall the chief executive authority], be responsible in any action or other legal proceedings whatsoever for any warrant issued by him in pursuance of this Act, or be examinable as a witness, except at his own request, in any court of justice in respect of the circumstances which led to the issue of the warrant.
