



Clerical Disabilities Act 1870

1870 CHAPTER 91 33 and 34 Vict

5 Provision for pending proceedings before recording in registry.

Provided, that if within the aforesaid period of six months the bishop to whom an office copy of the enrolment of a deed of relinquishment is delivered, or his successor in office, has notice of proceedings pending against the person executing the deed as a person who had been admitted to the office of minister in the Church of England, the bishop shall, on the application of that person, cause the deed to be recorded in the registry of the diocese on the termination of those proceedings by a definitive sentence, or interlocutory decree having the force and effect of a definitive sentence, and execution thereof, but not sooner.
