1871 CHAPTER 112

An Act for the more effectual Prevention of Crime.

[21st August 1871]

WHEREAS it is expedient to make further provision for the effectual prevention of crime:

Be it enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
