6 Payment of commutation moneys.

The Commissioners for the Reduction of the National Debt, . . . ^{F1}, may pay the amounts awarded as commutations of pensions out of any funds for the time being in their hands under the authority of [^{F2}the ^{M1}National Savings Bank Act 1971] . . . ^{F3}
