Legal Proceedings

20 Summary proceedings for offences, &c.

In England and Ireland all offences and penalties under this Act may be prosecuted and recovered in manner directed by the Summary Jurisdiction Acts, before a court of summary jurisdiction.

In Scotland all offences and penalties under this Act shall be prosecuted and recovered before a court of summary jurisdiction under the provisions of [FIPart II of the MICriminal Procedure (Scotland) Act 1975], and all necessary powers are hereby conferred on such court.
