



Colonial Clergy Act 1874

1874 CHAPTER 77 37 and 38 Vict

12 Archbishops may dispense with oath of due obedience.

It shall be lawful for the archbishop of Canterbury or the archbishop of York for the time being, in consecrating any person to the office of bishop for the purpose of exercising episcopal functions elsewhere than in England, to dispense, if he think fit, with the oath of due obedience to the archbishop.
