1875 CHAPTER 25 38 and 39 Vict

13 Provision for regimental necessities, &c.

The provisions of this Act relative to the taking out, destroying, or oblitering of marks, [^{F1}or to the having in possession or keeping Her Majesty's stores], shall not apply to stores issued as regimental necessities or otherwise for any soldier, . . . ^{F2}or volunteer; but nothing herein shall relieve any person from any obligation or liability to which he may be subject under any other Act in respect of any such stores.
