1875 CHAPTER 63 38 and 39 Vict

Proceedings against Offenders

24 In any prosecution defendant to prove that he is protected by exception or provision

In any prosecution under this Act, where the fact of an article having been sold in a mixed state has been proved, if the defendant shall desire to rely upon any exception or provision contained in this Act, it shall be incumbent upon him to prove the same.
